### Superintendent's Message

Fall is here with its cooler temperatures. This will slow the growth of the fairways, and we will begin raising the height of cut to protect the plant when it goes into dormancy. Cart traffic and freezing/thawing can damage the crown of the plant while it is dormant if there isn't enough leaf blade to insulate it from these conditions. With the constant rain, it seems like we may never get back to 90-degree rule. We were able to get the greens aerated and verticut during the frequent rain events. We were also able to apply pre-emergent to the fairways and roughs to reduce winter weeds.

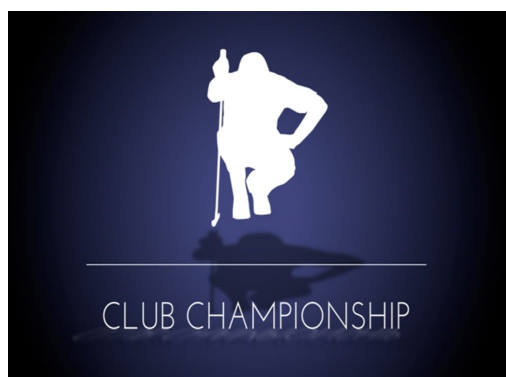




## GOLF NEWS
